#### Minutes

- 1. Christer opened the meeting by welcoming everyone to the 14<sup>th</sup> Steering Committee meeting. The minutes from the previous meeting were then briefly reviewed and action items will be covered during the meeting.

#### **Events & Activities**

- The **Innovation (scouting) Tour to Texas** is planned for February 5<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024. We will visit the universities in San Antonio, Austin, College Station, and Houston. Currently UU, LU, SU, LTU, MDU and MIUN are planning to participate in the trip.
- The SIREUS ENTREPREURS forum is being planned for the week of March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024, in Colorado. Nicole
  Forsberg from CU Boulder & SACC CO is our host, and she is working on the agenda for the forum. She is
  also setting up individual meetings for our visiting Swedish Start-ups. Currently UU, LU, SU, LTU, and LIU
  are planning to participate at the forum and currently there are 8-10 companies that have planned to
  participate.
- The **SIREUS CHANCELLORS forum** planned for the week of May13th, 2024, in Stockholm is now cancelled as per a decision during the previous meeting. Christer is preliminary looking in to arranging another event/delegation later during 2024. He will inform the Steering Committee accordingly of any new plans.

• The first **SIREUS RESEARCH forum** was held on December 11<sup>th</sup> @ 16:30 CET and had 60 participants. The second SIREUS RESEARCH forum is now being held on January 24<sup>th</sup> @ 16:30. SIREUS is planning the coming forums continuously and is welcoming any in out and feedback from the group.

#### **Thematic Areas**

Christer informed the group that he received a lot of positive feedback on the implementation of the thematic areas and links. He thanked all SIREUS Member universities providing relevant links. He has reached out to the Affiliated University Members and offered them the possibility to add links as well.

#### **Individual University Plans**

Christer informed that the university specific plans have been implemented in the archive on the website. Each university specific plan can only be accessed by that university's members.

#### **Financial Report**

Christer presented the financial report for December 2023 (=complete year of 2023) and emphasized that there are no surprises compared with the previous meeting. We had 13 KUSD in cash by year end. He also mentioned that he appreciated that he could send out the 2024 invoices in early January, since the cash is needed.

# **Budget 2024**

As per the previous meeting and in reference to the Stakeholders Group meeting in December, the Steering Committee had the task of approving the budget proposal for 2024. With a couple of minor changes to the legend of the budget proposal (still some Swedish words in the presentation), the budget proposal was approved unanimously.

Christer referred to the previous meeting and the formation of the Evaluation Team. The process has started, and the team is in place. There is still a possibility for members of the Steering Committee to participate – please let Christer know if you want to participate. Christer and Margareta presented the process more in detail and the thinking behind it.

Christer asked for feedback on the Evaluation and the role of the participants. Everyone agreed that this is a good plan, however a couple of comments regarding the number of meetings were brought up.

Some of the Evaluation Team also thought there were too many meetings. Christer understood the comment and promised to bring up the topic during the first virtual meeting.
