Opening of Meeting

Christer Bergman opened the meeting and presented the agenda;

Each university has one representative on the SIREUS Steering Committee. At today's meeting, some universities had more than one representative attending as some universities have been changing representatives. Going forward, the designated Steering Committee representative will represent the university at these meetings.

Progress Report

In Christer Bergman's project progress report, he noted that the progress is measured against the approved Project Plan and the only entity that can change the SIREUS Project Plan is the Steering Committee.

All documents have been translated into English. SACC-USA has held a SIREUS webinar with the 19 regional chambers to start the mapping actions as per the Project Plan. Pinevision AB+Inc. has been engaged for the web design. We welcome help with website content. The planned information portal will have three levels; one public, one accessible only to SIREUS members, and one accessible only to each individual university.

Niklas Myhr of Chapman University, aka the Social Media Professor, introduced himself and offered to advise and assist SIREUS with the social media strategy.

The current SIREUS logotype was shown along with an alternative one created by the web design team. Feedback on the choice of SIREUS logo is welcome.

New Governance Model

A contact database with university contacts for all SIREUS positions has been created. The new Governance Model and Organization is now included in the document titled *Project Plan 04202022*.

Christer Bergman will lead the implementation of Working Groups, which is next on the agenda. We will start with four working groups, one for each of the four goals stated in the SIREUS project plan. If the four working groups need to be adjusted, such adjustments will be made, following a formal decision by the SIREUS Steering Committee.

SIREUS Project Organization

Christer Bergman, Cecilia Kullman and Johan Marcus work part time for SIREUS. Christer as the Program Director, Cecilia as a Project Leader and Johan is operating in Sweden (mainly with the government funding). Karin Hammar has overall oversight as SACC-USA Executive Director and she and her staff are supporting different SIREUS activities. Vera Edwall and Märta Perhag are the current interns assisting part-time with the SIREUS project. Louise Murphy, JU, will start full-time in early June. Hanna Bergman, GU, and Louise Andersson, LU, will start full-time in mid-July.

SIREUS Financial Report

Christer Bergman presented how the financial reporting will be carried out going forward. SIREUS is a separate project within SACC-USA, with separate financial reporting and separate bank account.

A comment came up during the meeting that many universities in the project have difficulties accepting invoices sent via pdf. Preferably, invoices should be submitted via PEPPOL.

Complementary Funding

There is no available funding through the Swedish government for 2022. The SIREUS project aims to be included in funding budgets for 2023 and 2024.

SIREUS also pursues funding through various foundations and private trusts. A meeting is planned with Vinnova. We are in discussion with KK Stiftelsen. SSF and STINT cannot support the SIREUS project directly, however, individual universities/researchers/projects (or SIREUS working groups) may seek funding. We have initiated communication with the Wallenberg Foundation.
