  - January 31<sup>st</sup> Ist virtual meeting (Teams) @ 15.00 CET "Deciding on the key topics."
  - February 28<sup>th</sup> In-person meeting in Stockholm (@SU) 10:00 16:00 CET "Deciding on recommendations on the way forward."
  - March 7<sup>th</sup>
    2nd virtual meeting (Teams) @ 15.00 CET "Review of recommendations."
  - April 9<sup>th</sup>
    3rd virtual meeting (Teams) @ 15.00 CET "Agree on the recommendations."
  - April 16<sup>th</sup> Steering Committee should discuss the recommendations.
