(P coordinates other units within SACC-USA, SACC Regional Chambers, The Embassy, SI and other Team Sweden efforts)

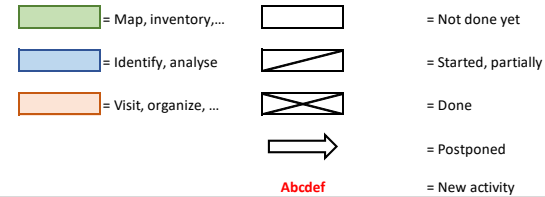
S = Resource in Sweden for contacts with business and relevant organisations.
